We are committed to protecting your privacy and personal information. By using our services you indicate that you agree to the following Terms & Conditions of Use. You may not use our service if you are not complying with any relevant laws and regulations that apply in your region.

We may occasionally update this Privacy Policy. When we do, we will revise the "last updated" date at the top of the Privacy Policy.

What personal data we collect and why we collect it

We collect information from you when you register on our site, or fill out a form. When registering on our website, as appropriate, you may be asked to enter your: name, e-mail address and birthday.

The personal information we collect from you include:

- Information about the device you use to browse our website.
- Your IP address.
- Any information you provide to us if you fill out a form or contact us.

The email address you provide may be used to send you information, respond to inquiries, and/or other requests or questions.

Do we disclose any information to outside parties?

We do not share, sell, trade or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information.

Legal data protection requirements

We regard the lawful and correct treatment of your personal information by us as very important to our successful operation, and to maintaining confidence between us and our users. We ensure that our organisation treats personal information lawfully and correctly. To this end we fully endorse and adhere to the 'Data Protection Principles' set out in the UK's Data Protection Act 1998.

In particular, without your consent, or first amending this Privacy Policy to reflect any change in our usage of personal information:

- we will not use your personal information for any purpose that is incompatible with this Privacy Policy;
- we will only collect sufficient personal information for the uses set out above;
- we will endeavour to keep your personal information up-to-date;
- we will not retain your personal information longer than necessary unless required to do so by law;
- we will operate appropriate technical and organisational processes to protect your personal information against unauthorised or unlawful access or processing and against accidental loss or destruction. The detailed measures we take are described elsewhere in this Privacy Policy; and
- we will not transfer your personal information to a country outside the European Economic Area unless safeguards are in place to protect your personal information to the standards that apply within the EEA including via standard contractual clauses and Privacy Shield.

Use of cookies

This website uses cookies. We use cookies to personalise content and ads, to provide social media features and to analyse our traffic. We also share information about your use of our site with our social media, advertising and analytics partners who may

combine it with other information that you've provided to them or that they've collected from your use of their services. You consent to our cookies if you continue to use our website.

Cookies are small text files that can be used by websites to make a user's experience more efficient. The law states that we can store cookies on your device if they are strictly necessary for the operation of this site. For all other types of cookies we need your permission. This site uses different types of cookies. Some cookies are placed by third party services that appear on our pages.

Cookies are small files that websites save to your hard disk or to your browser's memory. You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. If you have an account and you log in to this site, we will set a temporary cookie to determine if your browser accepts cookies. This cookie contains no personal data and is discarded when you close your browser. When you log in, we will also set up several cookies to save your login information and your screen display choices. Login cookies last for two days, and screen options cookies last for a year. If you log out of your account, the login cookies will be removed.

Google Analytics cookies for tracking purposes (`_ga`, `_gat`, `_gid`).

Analytics, Facebook pixel

The Data Controller embeds a JavaScript code (former conversion tracking pixel) into the webpage (or any of its subpages) using a so-called Facebook pixel tool that sends a message to Facebook when the user visits the page or executes an operation there. This on the one hand helps understand the return on your data advertising costs of the

Facebook remarketing

Based on all this, the Data Controller does not use analytical systems to collect personal information. The Data Controller alerts users to the fact that most Internet browsers automatically accept cookies, visitors, however, have the option to delete or reject them automatically. As each browser is different, the user can set cookie preferences individually using the browser toolbar. The Data Controller warns the users that certain features may not be used on a website if they choose not to accept cookies.

How long we retain your data

If you leave a comment, the comment and its metadata are retained indefinitely. This is so we can recognize and approve any follow-up comments automatically instead of holding them in a moderation queue.

Contact form entries are retained for 6 months, Google Analytics records for 50 months.

Your rights

You have the following rights in relation to your personal data:

- obtain access to your personal information.
- prevent processing that is likely to cause or is causing damage or distress.
- receive information about us and the purposes for which we process your personal data.
- ask us to correct any errors or delete the information we hold.

Security

We take many precautions to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your personal information. These precautions include:

- Use of SSL encryption for sensitive data.
- Hardware stored in secured data centres behind firewalls.
- All access to information restricted by password and/or secure key.

Whilst we take great care to ensure any confidential information remains protected we cannot guarantee the security of data sent over the Internet.

Of course you are responsible for keeping your password and user details confidential. Nobody at TIPROADO will ever ask you for your password, so please don't trust anybody asking you for it.
